Downloading system updates

Step 1: Creating an imprint of your R-Link 2 system



The first thing to do is to make an imprint of your R-Link 2 system on board your vehicle using a USB stick.

The USB stick must be blank with a minimum capacity of 8 gigabytes and in FAT32 format.



Get comfortably settled in your vehicle, start the engine and switch on your R-Link 2.



Put the USB stick in correctly.




Wait for 1 minute and then take out the USB stick. You have created an imprint of your R-Link 2 system.


Step 2: Selecting the system update




Go onto your computer and have the USB stick ready with the imprint of your R-Link 2 system on it.



Go onto the R-Link Store website.




Log in to your R-Link Store account using your log-in details.




A message will tell you if you have updates available. Click "Go to update".

A window displays the list of available updates.



If no message appears you can also check the available updates in the "Updates" menu in the R-Link Store.

Then click "Update".



An information window opens to tell you what to do. Please read what it says carefully and then close the window.

Step 3: Downloading



Run the R-Link 2 Toolbox on your PC.



Insert the USB flash drive which you used to perform the imprint of your R-Link 2 system.



R-Link 2 Toolbox recognises your vehicle automatically.

All of the system updates are now available for download.

Click the "Download to my USB flash drive" button to start downloading.



Please note that large updates can take quite a while, so we suggest that you check your computer won't go into sleep or power-saving mode while the update is in progress.



Once the download is complete, close the R-Link 2 Toolbox and safely remove the USB flash drive from your computer.

Step 4: Installing system updates on R-Link 2



To install system updates, get comfortably settled in your vehicle and use the USB stick with the download on.

Start the engine and leave it running throughout the installation.



Switch on your R-Link 2 and insert your USB stick.

Wait a few moments for R-Link 2 to recognize your USB stick.




Press "yes" to start installing the updates on your R-Link 2.

Downloading map updates

Step 1: Creating an imprint of your R-Link 2 system






Go onto your computer and have the USB stick ready with the imprint of your R-Link 2 system on it.




Go onto the R-Link Store website.




Log in to your R-Link Store account using your log-in details.

Then click "Update".




Step 3: Downloading



Launch the R-Link 2 Toolbox on your PC.




Insert the USB flash drive which you used to perform the imprint of your R-Link 2 system.




R-Link 2 Toolbox recognises your vehicle automatically.


