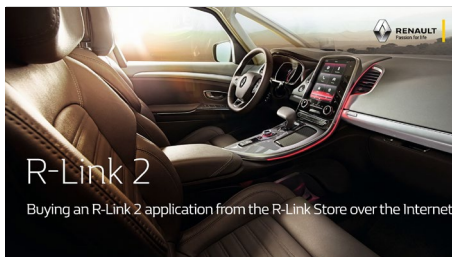

# 01

## Make an imprint



The first thing to do is to make an imprint of your R-Link 2 system on board your vehicle using a USB stick.

The USB stick must be blank with a minimum capacity of 8 gigabytes and in FAT32 format.



Get comfortably settled in your vehicle, start the engine and switch on your R-Link 2.



Put the USB stick in correctly.



Wait for 1 minute and then take out the USB stick. You have created an imprint of your R-Link 2 system.

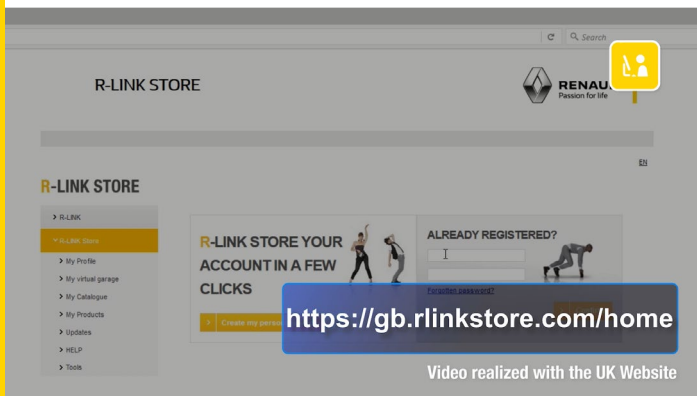

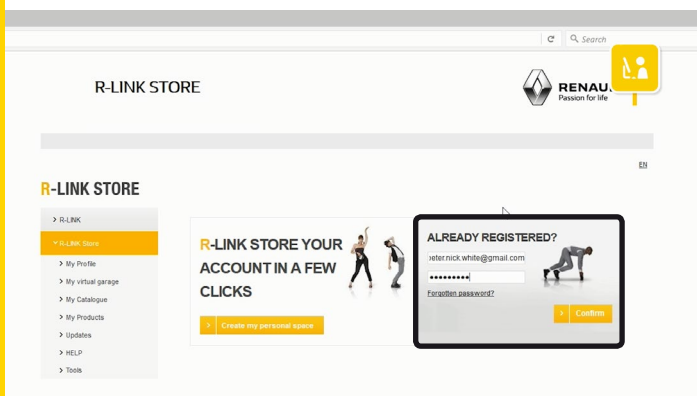
### Step 1: Choosing the application



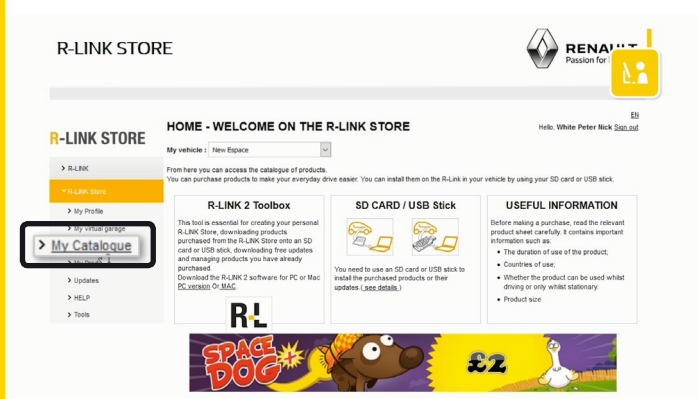
Go onto your computer and have the USB stick ready with the imprint of your R-Link 2 system on it.



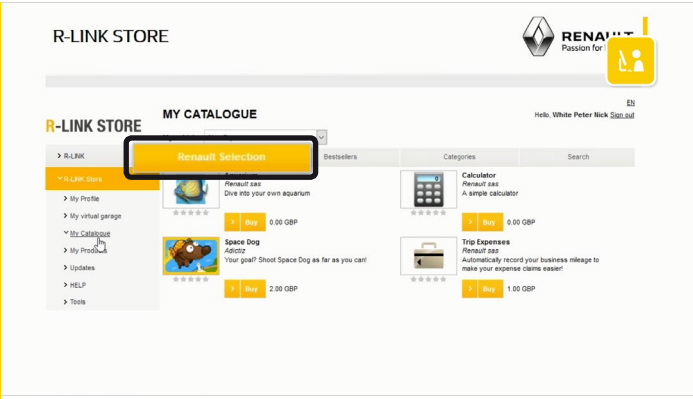
Go onto the R-Link Store website.



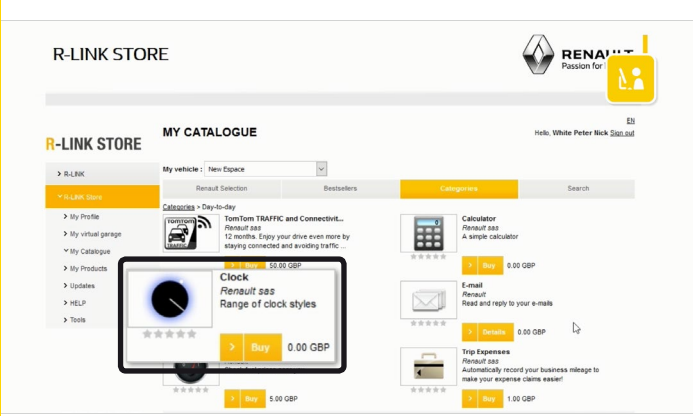
Log in to your R-Link Store account using your log-in details.



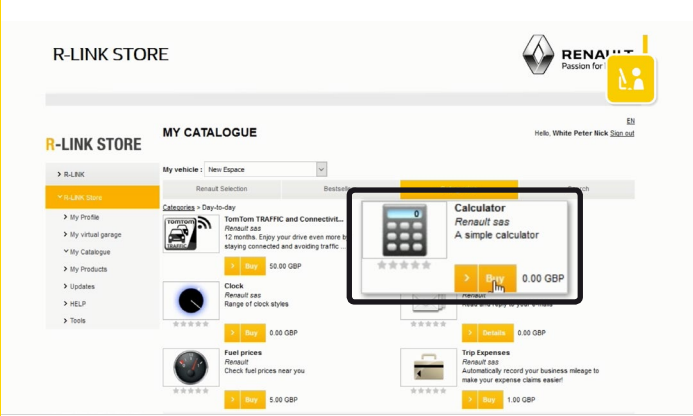
Lastly choose the "My catalogue" menu.



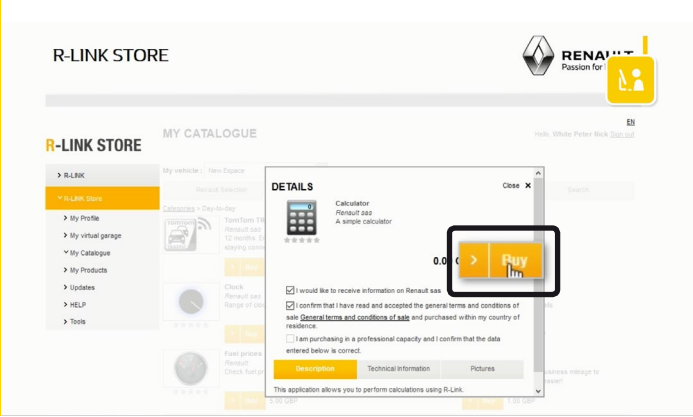
You have several options open to you for finding applications: the Renault selection, the top sellers, using the "Search" menu to search by category or keyword.



For each application you have its name, a descriptive picture, a short explanatory text and its price.



For example in the "Day to day" category, let's buy the free application "Calculator".

A minimum requirement for buying the application is that you tick the "General terms and conditions of sale".

Then click "Buy".

3 - Connect the SD card or USB stick to your vehicle. Your products will be automatically installed on the R-Link.

When you will insert your SD card in your vehicle again, your R-Link system will be unavailable throughout the update.

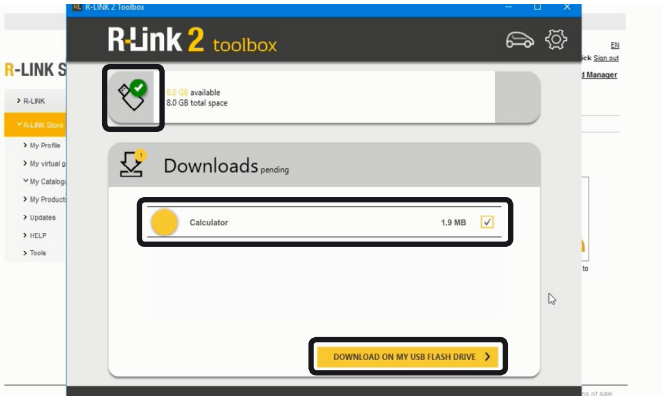
## Step 2: Downloading



Run the R-Link 2 Toolbox on your PC.



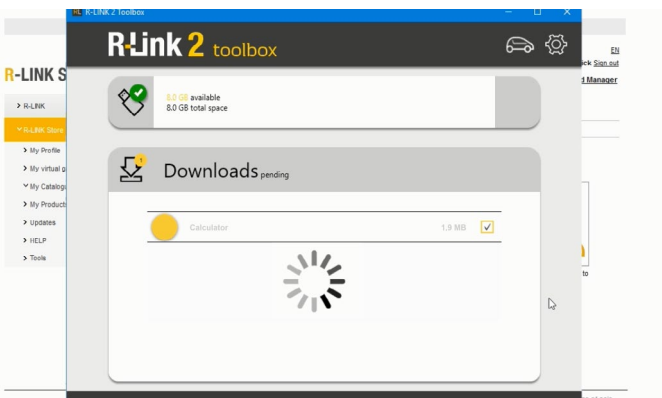
Insert the USB flash drive which you used to perform the imprint of your R-Link 2 system.



R-Link 2 Toolbox recognises your vehicle automatically.

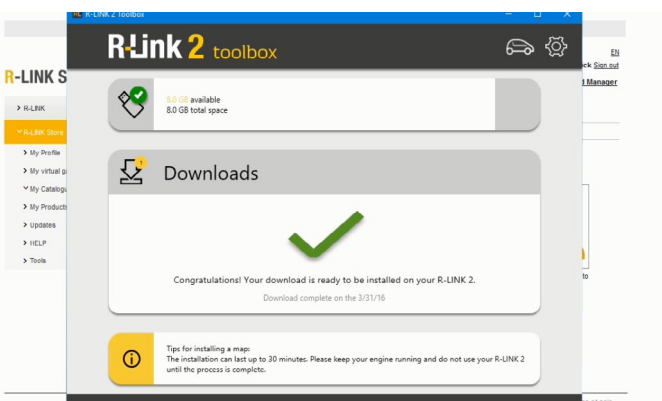
The “Calculator” application that you selected is there.

To start the download, click the “Download to my USB flash drive” button.



Please note that the download may take a while if it is a large application.

So we suggest that you check your computer won't go into sleep or power-saving mode while the update is in progress.



Once the download is complete, close the R-Link 2 Toolbox and safely remove the USB flash drive from your computer.

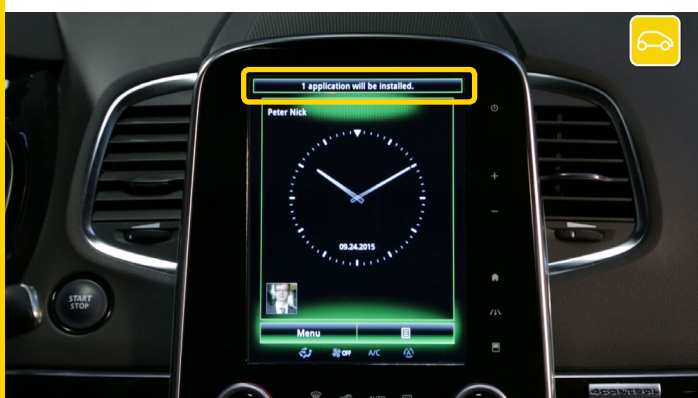


To install the free application, get comfortably settled in your vehicle and use the USB stick with the downloaded application on.

Start the engine and leave it running throughout the installation.



Switch on your R-Link 2 and insert your USB stick. Wait a few moments for R-Link 2 to recognize your USB stick.



The R-Link 2 system has detected your stick and is searching for information related to R-Link 2.



R-Link 2 will automatically prompt you to install the application you have downloaded onto your stick. Wait for installation to complete.

Please note that this process may take a while depending on the size of the files you're downloading.
